

Associate Dean, Outreach and Sponsored Research

Cornell University, ILR School

Linda Barrington is the Associate Dean for Outreach and Sponsored Research in the ILR School at Cornell University. She is also the Executive Director of the Institute for Compensation Studies (ICS), an interdisciplinary initiative that analyzes, teaches, and communicates broadly about monetary and non-monetary rewards from work.

Barrington has conducted research on gender economics, compensation, employees with disabilities, new workforce entrants, and the working poor. Her work appears in the *Review of Economics and Statistics*, the *Journal of Economic History*, and the *Historical Statistics of the U.S.*, as well as numerous business-research reports. Barrington's recent book, *Employment and Work - Disability: Key Issues and Future Directions*, is published in the SAGE Reference Series.

Barrington comes to the ILR School from The Conference Board, a global business membership and research organization. She began her career on the economics faculty at Barnard College of Columbia University and has also taught at Columbia's School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA), the University of Michigan, and the University of Illinois. She earned a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Illinois, and a B.S. in economics from the University of Wisconsin.

Your father shared your mother's write up about her own life and made many insightful comments about Barbara's life, motivations, and values. Well received by all."

In February we were honored to hear Jane Graham Jennings, Executive Director, **The Women's Community** Jane Graham Jennings is a captivating speaker who shared issues and challenges faced by both women and our community. She also helped us learn about resources that are available through The Women's Community. Having a heart-to-heart talk with Jane was very valuable.

In April, AAUW 2018 State Convention attendees Nancy Schulz, Lucy Harvey and Dido Nash went to the Convention with notebooks in hand. The AAUW National Board of Directors has voted to put three proposals for bylaws amendments before the membership for a vote this spring. The proposed amendments address (1) creating three-year staggered board terms, (2) opening board service to those outside of the AAUW membership, and (3) eliminating the degree requirement for membership.
